

INSTALLING A SUNLINE POOL BLANKET CAN SAVE YOU MORE THAN MONEY AND DEBRIS IN THE POOL...

YOU'LL BE SAVING THE SUN'S NATURAL WARMTH, ELIMINATE EVAPORATION AND REDUCE RUNNING COSTS IN TERMS OF MAINTENANCE AND POOL CHEMICAL CONSUMPTION.

A cost effective and convenient way to save water and heat your pool at the same time, Solar blankets are made from a film containing thousands of tiny bubbles which work together to collect and retain heat in your pool.

The blanket floats on top of the water (bubble side down) and allows solar energy to pass through - trapping and retaining the heat in your pool. Warming your pool by up to 8° and reducing heat loss by up to 75% by simply reducing water evaporation.




HOW DO SOLAR BLANKETS WORK?



Pool blankets are made from a film containing thousands of tiny bubbles, which work together to collect and retain heat in your pool. The blanket floats bubble side up, on top of the water and allows solar energy or sunlight to pass through: retaining the heat in your pool.

The pool water heats up by absorbing sunlight that heats the blanket. The water then cools the blanket. Like a heat exchange: The heat of the pool blanket is exchanged with the pool water. The more sunlight the pool gets the faster the pool will heat up. On average with full sun you can expect a degree a day so in about 6-9 days you will have about a 8 degree increase.

The air inside the bubbles is rapidly warmed by the sun, transferring heat to your pool water therefore allowing effective conduction to occur which minimizes the loss of heat into the air.




HOW DO I MEASURE THE POOL TO DETERMINE THE SIZE OF THE POOL BLANKET?



Simply measure the width and breadth of the pool as demonstrated below to attain the correct pool blanket size for your pool.

We recommend adding an extra 100mm to the overall size, to accommodate for shrinkage that may occur: Sunline Australia's premium grade pool cover material is manufactured to suit the harsh Australian climate and if cared for in the correct manner will not shrink. However there is a small amount of settlement in the material which accounts for less than 1% of the length of a pool cover.



ONCE I HAVE A COVER, HOW DO I STORE IT?



We recommend a quality Sunline Australia underground pool roller or above ground roller. Both have different advantages and disadvantages depending on your requirement. **Visit us at www.sunlineaustralia.com.au to find a roller to suit your need.**

ATTENTION!

- Pool blankets are not safety covers
- Not designed to support the weight of a person or pet
- Completely remove pool blanket before using the pool
- Never swim whilst the pool blanket is even partly on the pool
- Always remove the pool blanket when 'super chlorinating'
- Pool blankets need to be removed every 10 days - for 24hrs to avoid over chlorination. (For more details please check with your pool builder or pool manufacturer)

SAVE CHEMICAL LOSS

500 MICRON THICKNESS

In general, thicker blankets last longer than thinner covers. The disadvantage of a thicker blanket is they're heavier, less flexible and harder to handle.

However, generally the advantages of a slightly thicker pool cover greatly outweigh the negatives. A 500 micron pool cover is equivalent to 0.5mm in thickness. (The height of the bubble is not included in the measurement- just the thickness of the material.)
